Art & Makers' Shopping Sundays is an up-market contemporary art, craft and design fair in Leicester's Cultural Quarter.

We are looking for artists and designer/makers who create high quality, original and unique products to sell and promote their work on stalls at our November Sunday fairs. Stalls cost £35 the day or £50 for both Sundays and there is an application and selection process. For full information please see FAQs below.

The fair will take place in across the LCB Depot site and will be open to the public from 11am until 5pm.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is LCB Depot a Covid-19 Secure site?

Do I need to wear a face covering at the fair?

Under current Covid regulations, Yes, unless you are eating or drinking at one of the café's tables.

How are the exhibitors chosen?

A panel of tenants from [Makers' Yard](#) studios for artists & designer-makers will select makers from applications received by the deadline. We will be looking for a range of types of work from artists and designer/makers whose work is **high quality, original and unique**.

We regret that we cannot provide feedback on unsuccessful applications. If you are successful we will notify you and call to take payment (we will provide a receipt for this).

How much will a stall cost to hire?

A stall costs £35, for one Sunday or £50 for both

Is there a commission on sales?

No, LCB Depot will not take any commission on your sales. The only payment is for stall hire.

What display equipment will LCB Depot provide?

We will supply a table (size to be confirmed) and a chair, but you'll need to provide any other display and sales material (e.g. baskets, plinths, wrapping materials and any POS you may require). Electricity can be provided to some stalls – please state if this is needed on the form.

Can I fix work to the walls?

No.

Can I share a stall?

No, unless with a business partner and part of your social bubble.

What about cancellations?

Time is tight due to the late launch of this please only cancel if related to any Covid related circumstances will we refund your successful application fee. If you have to cancel for different reasons we will try to sell the space and a refund will depend on whether we are successful. If we cancel the event, we'll refund your application fee in full but we will not pay for any additional expenses you incur as a result of our cancellation.

Are makers insured at the fair?

You are responsible for your own insurance of your work and for public liability. This is an event open to the public and you are advised to attend and monitor your exhibition space, your work, and any personal belongings at all times. None of the organisations organising the event will be held responsible for any loss or damage.

What marketing will be done for the event?

The events will be publicised on: <http://www.lcbdepot.co.uk/>, along with Leicester City Council, LOVE Art and Leicester Art Week, and through an Etsy network. LCB Depot's website will have images of all stall-holders' work. And all will appear on LCB and Makers' Yard social media accounts. Our partners and yourselves will be encouraged to share posts as they are posted

How busy will it be?

Times are different and there is safe restriction to consider to ensure we are not helping with the spread of Covid-19

The events will be ticketed, to ensure a safe site for both stallholders and customers. Tickets will be allocated to 5 one hours slot between 11am and 5pm across each Sunday.

The ticket sales will ~~have~~ help manage numbers and attract buyers over browsers.

What time can I arrive to set up my stall?

LCB Depot will open at 8am for setup from the main entrance on Rutland Street. You will be allotted a staggered arrival time between 8am and 9am to make it easy and safer for all.

Will I be able to park near LCB Depot?

You can park in the nearby NCP Rutland Centre car park at 56 Halford Street, LE1 1TQ all day for £5.50 if you get your ticket validated on entry to LCB Depot with the site staff.

How do I get my stuff out at the end of the day?

You can pack up your stuff and carry it out to wherever you are parked, or you could drive your vehicle to outside LCB Depot to load up – but much of Rutland Street is on double yellow lines, so you can load/unload only.

Will there be facilities to take payment by credit/debit card?

No, all stall holders are encouraged to take credit card payment from customers and must have that facility themselves to do so.

What facilities will be available on the day?

LCB Depot's café will be open serving a limited menu hot and cold food, and drinks. The toilets have disabled access and baby changing facilities.
